MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IN THE FIELD OF ELECTRONIC
COMMUNICATIONS

BETWEEN

THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES AND COMMUNICATIONS AUTHORITY
OF TURKEY

AND

THE AGENCY FOR ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND POSTAL SERVICES
OF MONTENEGRO

The Information Technologies and Communications Authority of the Republic of Turkey and the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services of Montenegro (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties"),

Proceeding to further extend friendly relations between the two administrations on the basis of equality and mutual benefit,

Recognizing the importance of electronic communications for the development of their relations and their better mutual understanding,

Considering:

- a. The purpose of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) to strengthen relations between various countries;
- b. The correlation between plans and programs;
- c. The benefits for the Information Technologies and Communications Authority of the Republic of Turkey and the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services of Montenegro that may accrue from the co-operation between the two administrations in the matters concerning the exchange of information, experience and documents related to the development of electronic communications services in both countries;

Convinced of the need for and desirability of greater cooperation between the two administrations,

hereby agree to cooperate with the purpose of:

Article 1 *Exchange of Information and Documentation*

The Parties will increase the exchange of information and documents related to electronic communications services.

Article 2 *Coordination of Views*

The Parties will coordinate, as much as possible, their views on the matters of mutual interest.

Article 3 *Development of electronic communications services*

The Parties will establish full cooperation in the matters related to the development of electronic communications services in both countries by exchanging the experience and relevant documents.

Article 4 *Communication*

The Parties will establish regular channels of communication by designating a work group or individual points of contact in order to fulfill the objectives referred to in previous articles.

Article 5 *Areas of focus*

The Parties will, on periodical basis, seek to agree on the areas of particular mutual interest, which should be the focus of attention.

Article 6 *Review*

The Parties will review on a biennial basis the results and their cooperation under this Memorandum of Understanding. The Parties will consider the need for improvements in their cooperation and make suitable proposals for modifying the scope of this Memorandum of Understanding, as appropriate.



Article 7 *Entry into Force and Termination*

This Memorandum of Understanding enters into force on the date set forth below, and may be terminated by either party one (1) month upon prior written notice to the other party.

Made in 4 (four) copies in the English language, each party keeping 2 (two) of them.

Both copies are equally valid.


